New Lectionary for Mass On the 1 <sup>st</sup> Sunday of Advent this year we will begin using a new lectionary, ie a different translation of the scriptures from that which we currently use. "The new Lectionary will use the English Standard Version – Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is more 'proclaimable' and, where appropriate, more inclusive". Each parish has to purchase new sets of Lectionaries for the Lectern. Lectio	<b>First Holy Communions Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> July</b> We have 17 children from 5 different schools preparing to make their first Holy Communion on Saturday July 6 <sup>th</sup> at 11.00am Mass. We hope to follow this with a shared table celebration in the hall.
