Saint Patrick's Feast Day 17th March



Contrary to popular belief Ireland's National colour has not always been green. *Saint Patrick's* colour was *blue*, and from the 12th century blue adorned the Ancient Irish flags and the Royal Court.

The Shamrock has always been the National emblem of Ireland and its banning by the English only served to strengthen its symbolism reflected in the green uniforms worn by Irish soldiers to show their solidarity against the British who wore red.

During the rebellion of 1798 the clover became a symbol of nationalism and the "wearing of the green" on lapels became regular practice.

Green began to symbolise the Irish and became synonymous with *St. Patrick's* Day.






BONUS BALL numbers are still available: please see Richard at the back of Church. This provides good income for our Parish.
